1.	What is the date of the Test?	23 <sup>rd</sup> and 24 <sup>th</sup> October 2021
2.	What is the mode of Test	Exam will be delivered online (internet based) on a android Mobile phones/laptop/ PCs fitted with camera.
3.	Do I have to visit any Test centre?	No. You are not required to visit any Test centre. You can take the Test wherever you are on a android mobile/laptop/PC with internet connectivity.
4.	Can I take the exam on Mobile Phone?	Yes only android mobile phones.
5.	Methods of taking of test	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. If a candidate wants to take test through Laptop/Personal Computer, s/he has to install the Safe Exam browser.</li><li>2. If a candidate wants to take test through Android Mobile Phones, s/he has to download the Android application package (.apk) file.</li></ol>
6.	What is the mock test date and timings	21 <sup>st</sup> October 2021. The mock test window will be open from 10.00 am to 06.00 pm during the period.
7.	How will I know how to take the mock test?	NTA will be conducting webinars to familiarise the candidates about the online Test. Date/timings of the webinars will be sent to the candidates by email.

9.	Is it compulsory to take the mock test?	Yes. Mock test has been organised to ensure that candidates get familiar with the online exam process and do not face any problem on the actual Test date.
10.	Where/How do I take the mock test?	<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. If a candidate wants to take test through Laptop/Personal Computer, s/he has to install the Safe Exam browser, enter the User ID and Your Password for taking the test</li><li>2. If a candidate wants to take test through Android Mobile Phones, s/he has to download the Android</li></ol>

		<p>application package (.apk) file enter the User ID and Your Password for taking the test</p> <p>3. User ID and Your Password would be same for <b>mock test</b> and <b>main test</b></p>
11.	What is the duration of mock test?	30 minutes
12.	Will my user ID and password be the same for mock test and actual Test?	Yes
13.	What are the Test timings	As mentioned in Admit Cards
14.	What is the reporting time	30 minutes before the test
15.	Why am I asked to log in so early before the Test?	Some candidates may face difficulties in downloading the Safe Exam Browser or have issues with the link for taking the test so last minute issues can be avoided. Further, the process of validating the identity of the candidates and admitting them to the online exam in the system, also takes time. Hence, candidates are required to log in 30 minutes before the test so that issues that may arise during log-in can be resolved and candidates would be able to take the Test in peace without any stress.
16.	If am late by few minutes, can I still be admitted?	No
17.	If I finish the paper before time, can I leave the Test?	Yes. Once you finish the paper, you can click on the “Submit” button and leave the Test. Remember: Feedback form has to be filled.
18.	What are the things I can keep with me during the Test?	<p>You may keep the following with you during the Test:</p> <p>Admit Card</p> <p>2 sheets of plain paper for doing rough work.</p> <p>Drinking water in a transparent bottle</p>
19.	Is internet connectivity required throughout the Test?	Yes. The minimum required bandwidth is 1 Mbps of internet speed on each machine.
20.	Can I keep some sheets of paper for doing rough work, during the Test?	Yes
